



Admission Guidelines

St. Patrick will adhere to the policy that every person, as a child of God, regardless of race, condition, or age has equal dignity and an inalienable right to an education. Therefore, no students will be denied admission to this school on the basis of sex, race, color, or national origin.

All new students entering St. Patrick School are on probation for the first year. Continued academic and or behavioral difficulties will be cause for dismissal.

Nursery and Pre-K

St. Patrick Parish will be offering a discounted tuition for Nursery and Pre-K to families who commit to continuing their education in St. Patrick School beyond Kindergarten. All families will be required to submit a signed contract.

Since we offer discounted tuition, it is necessary to select students who qualify in the following order of priority:

- A) Siblings of present members of St. Patrick School
- B) Children of registered, and supporting members of St. Patrick Parish that live within the Parish borders

All other applicants will be wait-listed. If seats are available, we will accept tuition for:

- C) Children of Catholics from other parishes
- D) Children of non-Catholics

Registration Steps:

1. Complete an information form
2. Screening of the child's academic, emotional, and developmental readiness for the upcoming academic year
3. Registration
 - a. Application
 - b. Principal Interview
 - c. Birth Certificate
 - d. Baptismal Certificate
 - e. Health & Social History
 - f. Immunization Record
 - g. Physical
 - h. Deposit: non- refundable, not applied to tuition
 - i. Fact Form
 - j. Volunteer Form
 - k. Virtus Certificate

Once all registration steps are completed and approved, you will receive an acceptance letter.

Kindergarten

Admission is based on the child's readiness for school. Placement in our Pre-K program does not guarantee automatic admission to our Kindergarten program. Some students may be better served by an additional year of Pre-K to prepare for academic, emotional, and developmental readiness and will be invited to reapply the following year.

Registration Steps:

1. Complete an information form
2. Screening of the child's academic, emotional, and developmental readiness for the upcoming academic year

 - b. Birth Certificate
 - c. Baptismal Certificate
 - d. Health & Social History
 - e. Physical
 - f. Immunization Record
 - g. Deposit-non refundable
 - h. Transportation Form
 - i. Textbook Form
 - j. Uniform Order Form from Lobel's
 - k. Volunteer Consent Form
 - l. Virtus Training Certificate

Once all registration steps are completed and approved, you will receive an acceptance letter detailing the next steps. No registration is finalized without the completion of all these steps.

Transfers for Students in Grades 1-7

We, at St. Patrick School, are a strong academic school community. Therefore, admission to grades 1-7 will be considered only if seating is available and, at the discretion of the administration, St. Patrick School will meet your child's academic, emotional, and social needs. Furthermore, the willingness of the family to work within the structure of the school community at St. Patrick School will also be considered.

Registration Criteria:

1. Provide current report card
 - a. Your child must have passed all subjects in their previous school.
 - b. Your child must also show satisfactory remarks in the area of personal and social growth.
 2. Standardized Testing Scores
- Once registration criteria is met, the registration application for St. Patrick School will begin
1. Screening
 2. Principal Interview
 3. Full proof of Immunizations, Health Record, and Physical
